

Fantastic roe buck area with beautiful nature. It is a unique experience found only in England!









Overview

We have rare access to a fantastic district of 20.000 ha. just south of Oxford, which can offer really excellent roebucks.

Annually between 75-100 bucks are taken in this district, around half of which are medals, and as many as 15-20 of them being of gold medal standard! In other words it really is a medal winning district. A 500g buck costs only around USD 2800.

Due to very strict english weapon regulations we do not recommend bringing own rifle. You can rent good quality rifles at the area.

The price for the hunt and stay may seem a bit excessive but the very reasonable trophy prices surely compensate for that.

The hunt is typically 1: 1 in this area to optimize the chance of trophies. The hunter must also be aware that hunting, in this area, primarily takes the form of lying-inwait, so if you dream about stalk hunting this area is not ideal.

This hunting area is for the hunter who wants to put down his dream trophy!

Typically hunting is guided 1:1 in this district to optimize the chance of a trophy. Hunters should take note that hunting in this district is primarily carried out as lying in wait, so if you dream of stalking your way to a medal winning trophy, this is not the ideal district.

This district is perfect for hunters whose goal is to shoot the trophy of their dreams!
